Radiologic Technology (RT) Program
Admissions Criteria - Fall 2012

I. *Program Pre-Requisites*

- Minimum of 2 years of High School Mathematics
 - Math A & B (NYS Regents)
 - Or
 - Algebra & Geometry (NYS Regents)

*Course Average (in each of above) must be 75% or higher; Passing grade on Regents Exam preferred

- Minimum of 3 years High School Science (with laboratory components in each)*
 - Biology (Living Environment) (NYS Regents)
 - Chemistry (NYS Regents)
 - Physics (NYS Regents)

*Course Average (in each of above) must be 75% or higher; Passing grade on Regents Exam preferred

- 85% (or higher) **overall** High School Average

*If above high school courses were taken at a school that did not offer NYS Regents examinations (i.e. private school, other state, other country), course syllabi will be reviewed on an individual basis to meet RT Program pre-requisites.

- College Placement Test must be completed prior to review date

*Please Note: Completion of Radiologic Technology program pre-requisites does **not** guarantee admission into the program core!

II. College Transfer Criteria

- **MINIMUM GPA Requirement – 2.75 (cumulative)**
- Trocaire College will accept courses (for transfer credit) from other educational institutions; a minimum grade of “C” is required for these courses. Any science course must have been taken within 5 years. **This does not include prerequisite coursework.**
- All transfer students’ documentation must be received by Trocaire College by **June 1, 2012**. There are absolutely no exceptions to this criteria!

EARLY DECISION

Admission into the Radiologic Technology Program is highly competitive. Those students who have met **all** program pre-requisites as listed above, and who have attained an overall **college** cumulative average of a 3.5 (or higher) **MAY BE CONSIDERED** for Early Decision for the RT Program. Students will be notified by the RT Program Director of this decision by the end of January 2012.

HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS

A limited number of spaces will be allocated for high school students that are qualified to directly enter the program in the fall. An updated transcript with mid-year grades must be submitted in December to aid in the decision process. **High school students are ranked by cumulative GPA** and initial review will occur during January 2012. All program prerequisites must be completed prior to graduation.

FINAL REVIEW

For those students with an overall cumulative average of 2.75 thru 4.0, **all** RT Program pre-requisites must be completed by June 1, 2012 for fall consideration. **Students will be ranked according to cumulative GPA.** Notification of acceptance (by RT Program Director) will occur during the month of June 2012.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- **The number of spaces available for the RT Program will vary on a yearly basis. Applicants will be reviewed on an annual basis. If an applicant is not selected and still interested, he/she will be required to submit a new application for the following year.**
- **There is no waiting-list for this program.**
- **Trocaire College time deadlines are strictly enforced.**
- **If you are interested in the Radiologic Technology Program, you are encouraged to apply early.**
